

Market Report | March 2025

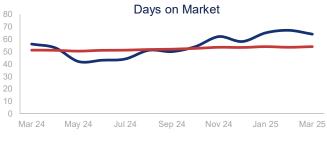
WEBER COUNTY

Highlights:

- Median Sales Price is up 4.3% over a 12 month rolling average and even from the same month last year.
- Inventory of Homes for Sale is up 21.8% over a 12 month rolling average and up 57.3% from the same month last year.
- Days on Market is up 5.5% over a 12 month rolling average and up 14.3% from the same month last year.



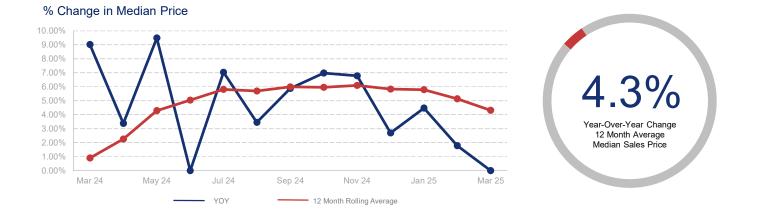
